HON. LARRY V. STARCHER served as a Justice on the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia from 1997 – 2008, serving as the Court’s Chief Justice in 1999 and 2003. He served as a Monongalia County Circuit Court Judge from 1977 – 1996, eighteen years as the Court’s Chief Judge. Justice Starcher retired from the Supreme Court at the end of 2008 and became a Senior Status Justice/Judge and now teaches at the West Virginia University College of Law. Justice Starcher was President of the West Virginia Judicial Association in 1992-93, and has served on the Martin Luther King, Jr. West Virginia Holiday Commission since 2004. He has three children who are WVU graduates, as are their spouses. His children hold degrees in Law, Medicine, and Public Administration – all from WVU.
